Please note: vaccines will not be given if payment is not present at time of service.** Please make all boarders aware of our policy. We accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express. Stool Exams

Our current deworming protocol recommends stool exams every spring and fall which we offer at a discounted rate. Please have your specimen (3-5 fecal balls) collected in a ziplock bag and labeled with Owner's Name and Patient's Name prior to Dr. Miller's arrival if you would like your stool exams performed in conjunction with your spring and fall vaccines. Stool exams can also be dropped off at the clinic address listed above.
